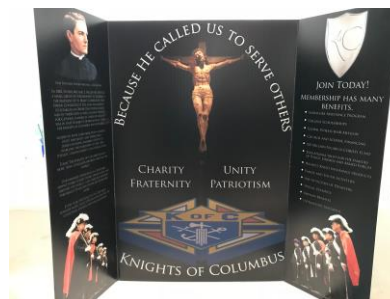

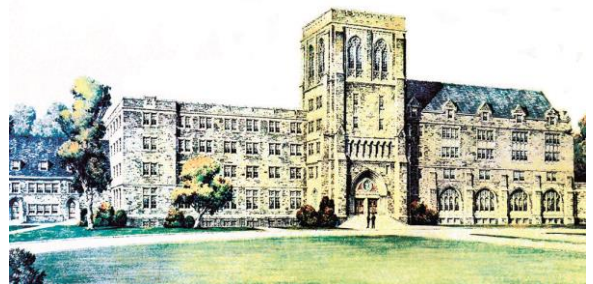
Lifehouse Golf Scramble is success
